

# Pupils, Curriculum and Quality Committee

## Terms of reference:

1. To elect a chair and vice chair of this meeting at the first meeting of the academic year.
2. To consider and advise the governing body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements and the School's Curriculum Policy
3. To consider curricular issues which have implications for Personnel, Finance and Buildings decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the Governing Body
4. To make arrangements for the Governing Body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the LA and for reports to be received by the Governing Body
5. To oversee arrangements for individual governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision if appropriate, e.g. Literacy, Numeracy, Science, Music, Sport, PSHE, Communications etc.
6. To receive regular reports from subject leaders and associated governors and to advise the Governing Body.
7. To oversee arrangements for educational visits, including the appointment of a named co-ordinator
8. To monitor and evaluate the progress of the school improvement plan and feed back to the full governing body.
9. To review policy and provision for sex & relationships education & drug education as well as collective worship and RE and to make recommendations where necessary
10. To monitor and review arrangements for staff training.
11. To monitor and review information about school performance
12. To monitor the quality of learning and teaching
13. To monitor inclusive practice and review information
14. To monitor support provided to parents and students and ensure that opinions and views are sought and acted on.
